- **Religious Education Teachers** (instruction and materials provided)—please circle preferred level:

WORKS OF MERCY

8. **Minister of the Sick** (instruction provided)—visit the sick or older members of the parish in their homes, nursing homes, or hospitals. Some visitors also bring the Eucharist to those who are unable to attend Mass.
9. **New Life** (prison) Ministry (instruction provided)—mentor and support women during the transition from prison to civilian life. Meets the first Thursday morning of each month. Other meeting times depend on need and availability.
10. **Pro-Life**—help promote awareness of pro-life issues, including abortion, capital punishment and euthanasia.
11. **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)**—in November and during Lent, meet during the 10.30 Mass and on Monday evenings.

12. **New London Meal Center**—six times a year, Christ the King provides a Sunday dinner. Volunteers are needed each time to:
 - a. Plan the menu, get sign-up materials and lead the group to New London
 - b. After weekend Masses, sign up volunteers for the following week
 - c. Prepare, at home, part of the meal
 - d. Serve and share the meal at the Center
13. **Plus One Project**—picks up donations of food at the A&P and brings them to the Shoreline Food Pantry at the Old Lyme Congregational Church. Christ the King is responsible one week per month.
14. **Shoreline Food Pantry**—located at the Old Lyme Congregational Church, duties include:
 - a. Sort food and stock shelves with groceries on Friday mornings
 - b. Help distribute food on Saturday mornings
15. **Shoreline Soup Kitchen**—located at the Old Lyme Congregational Church, Christ the King is responsible for six Saturdays a year. Hours are 8.30-noon and needs include:
 - a. A coordinator to plan menu, get sign-up materials and lead the group
 - b. After weekend Masses sign up parish volunteers for the following week
 - c. Help prepare, serve, and share the meal
16. **St. Vincent de Paul Place**, Norwich—once a month, deliver food collected at Christ the King.

17. **Harvest Fun Day** (Autumn)—needs include:
 - a. General chairperson(s) to coordinate one-day family event
 - b. Chairpersons for bake sale, entertainment, food, games, plant sale, publicity, tickets, vendors and Kings Rummage Sale
 - c. Worker
18. **Men's Club**—the Men's Club meets, usually on the first Thursday night of the month, for fellowship and to sponsor spiritual, service, and social activities
19. **Parish Life!** (quarterly newsletter):
 - a. Help write and/or edit articles
 - b. Photography
20. **Parish Suppers**—help with a parish supper (e.g., St. Patrick's Day, Mardi Gras, spaghetti, etc.)
 - a. Decorate/set-up
 - b. Cook
 - c. Serve
 - d. Clean up
21. **Receptions**—set up and/or clean up for special occasions, i.e., funerals, weddings, etc.

SERVICE

22. **Baking**—for receptions, bake sales, and other parish gatherings
23. **Collection Counters**—help count the money from the Offertory collection after Mass
