4. Retreat Experience: (1 required) Date TBD.

5. Parish Service: (5 required)

Assist in social and educational programs. Serve as collector, lector, altar server, sacristan etc. The Youth Mass is the **3rd Sunday of the month @ 10:30 a.m.** Baby-sit (**for free**) for children so parents may come to a church function. Special Prayer Celebrations/Communal Penance Service. Help with C.C.D.

6. Social Justice: (5 required)

Help at the Soup Kitchen in New London and Old Lyme. New London is every other month, the 3rd Sunday of the month. Old Lyme is every Saturday A.M. @ The Congregational Church; you can serve, pack bags of groceries, etc. Lyme Youth Service, Fire Department, or other Community Volunteer Work.

7. Socials: (3 required)

Parish or Diocesan sponsored activities. Examples are Pizza Night, Bowling, Parish Coffee Hours or Dinners.

8. Mass:

Candidates are required to attend Saturday Vigil or Sunday Morning Mass. Have the Pastor, Deacon or Mrs. Young sign off on a bulletin and bring to class that night.
