Special Prayer Celebrations/Communal Penance Service. Help with C.C.D.)

6. Social Justice: (5 required)

Help at the Soup Kitchen in New London and Old Lyme. New London is every other month, the 3rd Sunday of the month. Old Lyme is every Saturday A.M. @ The Congregational Church, you can serve, pack bags of groceries, etc. Lyme Youth Service, Fire Department, or other Community Volunteer Work.

7. Socials: (3 required)

Parish or Diocesan sponsored activities. Examples are Pizza Night, Bowling, Parish Coffee Hours or Dinners.

8. Mass:
