**Dear Father Ashe and Parishioners:**

On behalf of those we serve, I would like to extend my heartfelt thanks to each of you for your generous gifts to the **2025 One Faith, One Family Annual Catholic Appeal**. Despite the personal challenges many of you may have faced, you remained steadfast in your commitment to supporting the many ministries and programs benefited by the ACA that carry on Christ's work; feeding the hungry, caring for the sick, elderly, and homeless, educating the young and old alike, spreading the gospel and offering hope and renewal to those in need.


