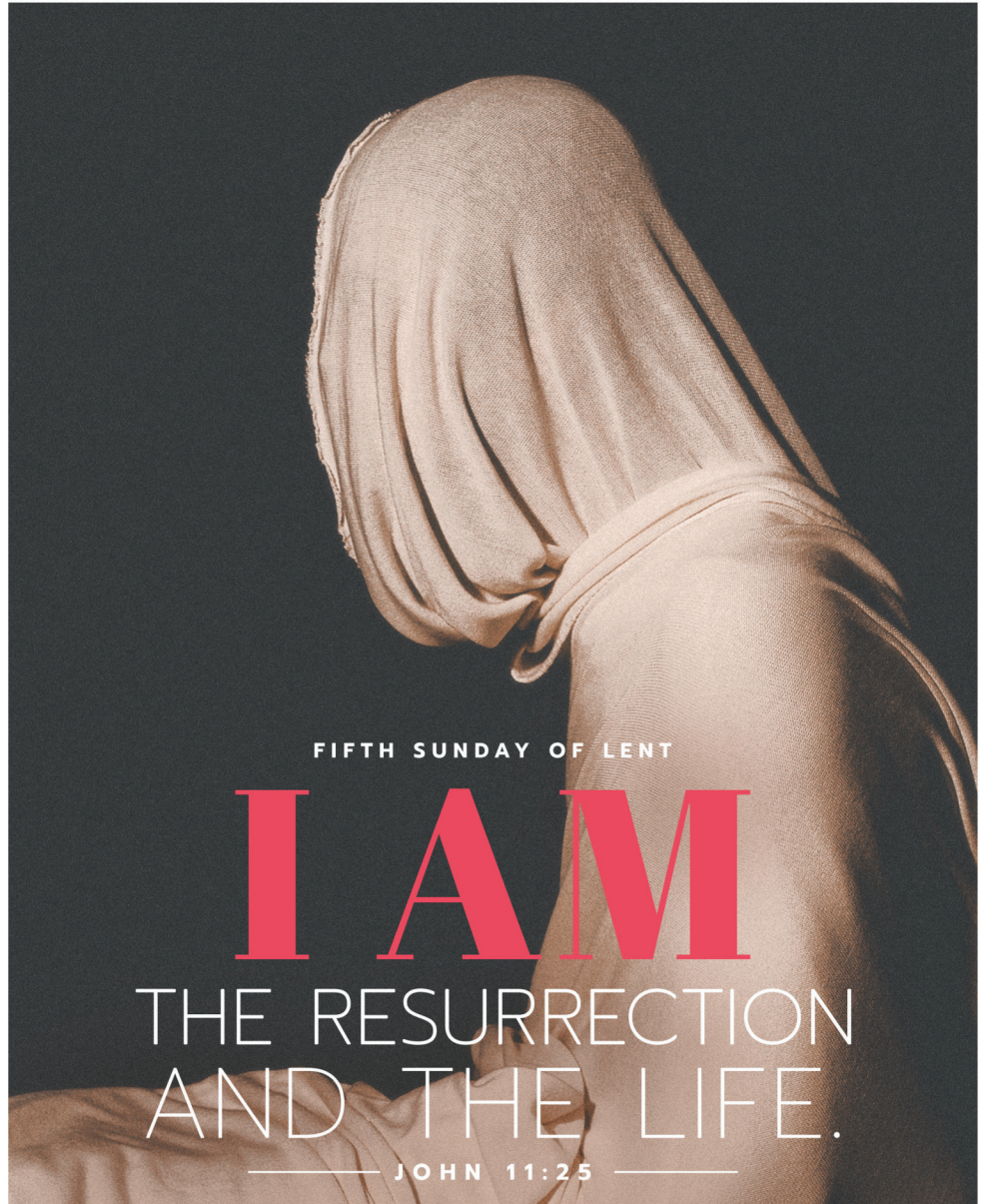

Stewardship Corner

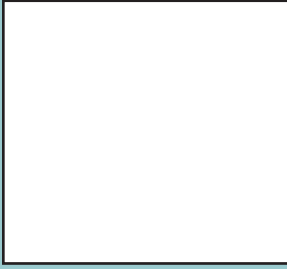

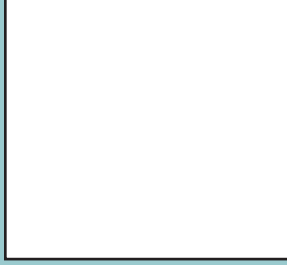
