Opening Prayer: Father Joe

Meditation: On Faith

Mark 5:34 "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace and be cured of your disease." Mark 10:51-52 And Jesus said to him, "What do you want me to do for you?" And the blind man said to him, "Rabbi, let me recover my sight." And Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well." And immediately he recovered his sight and followed him on the way.

Matthew 17:20-21 "For truly I tell you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you." Matthew 9:28-29 When he entered the house, the blind men approached him and Jesus said "Do you believe that I can do this?" "Yes, Lord", they said to him. Then he touched their eyes and said, "Let it be done for you according to your faith".

Agenda:

Ray Belval will give a presentation on the AED and CPR instruction available. The presentation is expected to last about an hour.

In Rhode Island it is law that any building with a capacity of over 300 has to have an AED. Early defibrillation and early CPR is crucial. Every minute that a person in cardiac arrest does not have care cuts their chance of survival by 10%.

We know the importance of Naloxone kits.

Bleeding Control

Bleeding emergencies can happen anywhere, so it's good to be prepared for those. Bleeding Control kits cost \$50-\$60.

- 1. The kit contains shears, gloves, gauze treated with a clotting agent, an emergency blanket
- 2. Put on the gloves and cut away clothing.
- 3. Find out where the bleeding is coming from. There may be more than one injury.
 - a. Put the gauze on the wound and apply pressure
 - b. For deeper wounds, pack the wound by putting gauze inside
 - c. In serious situations, put a tourniquet between the wound and the heart

CPR

Cardiac arrest can be caused by electrocution, drowning, getting hit in the chest, Heart attack If someone goes down

- 1. Check that the scene is safe
- 2. Look, listen, and feel for breathing for 5-10 minutes
- 3. Apply chest compressions (about 100 per minute) to the center of the chest at the nipple line
- 4. Get the AED as quickly as possible and follow the directions

To get an AED and the box (including sign, stickers on the window) costs about \$2000.

Narcan

- What's in the kit is a nasal spray. Some are to spray in one nostril, others in two
- If you're not sure if someone is overdosing or not, Narcan won't negatively affect them. Better safe than sorry.

Getting Equipment

- As a public building, it could be a good idea to have a bleeding control kit, an AED, and a Narcan kit.
- We might be able to use ARPA funds.
- If someone is trained in Narcan, they can get these kits for free.
- Ray Belval could provide a training.
- A group of 10-12 people would be an ideal size for training (it helps with hands on).
- We applied for a grant at inaheartbeat.org

Maintaining an AED

- The batteries on AEDs last a long time. Some of them take a special battery, but there are some that run on off the shelf batteries.
- The pads have an expiration date, so we would also have to watch that they don't expire.

The term of the office is **two years** or until their successors are duly selected.

Page 6 Article XI – Parish Annual Meeting and Report

The Council shall publish an annual report to the parish community. The purpose of the annual report is to present to the parish community the status of the parish finances and programs along with plans and objectives for the coming year.
